In brief, the complications involve the State Historic Preservation Organization (SHPO), the Uncas Health District, the Department of Transportation, and the Connecticut State Library.

When the town approved the library building project in May 2015, no one could have expected these obstacles. We are grateful for the support of the town, the library patrons, the Library Building Committee, and the Board of Selectmen, who have worked tirelessly on this renovation.

We will keep you informed as these issues are resolved.

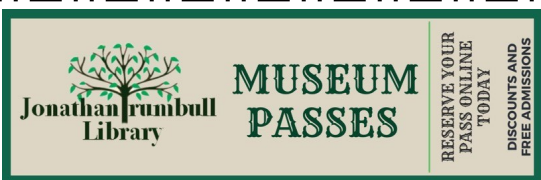
