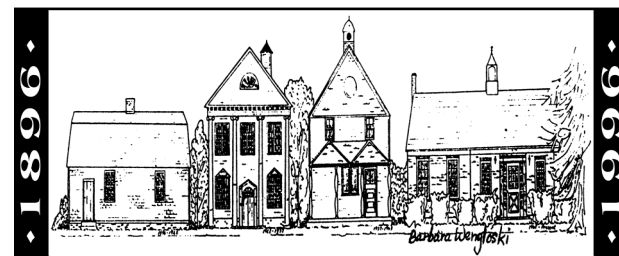

Welcome to the Jonathan Trumbull Library located on the historic Lebanon Green in the center of town. Lebanon's public library was established on October 5, 1896.

Download eBooks and Audios

You can download eBooks, audiobooks, magazines, and videos using your JTL library card number, from the library website or by downloading the Libby, Hoopla, and Kanopy apps to your mobile device. Find links on our website.

Fax, Photocopier, and Printer

The fees for these services are as follows: \$.15 per page is charged for printing and photocopying in black and white, and \$.50 per page for color. Faxes may be sent at \$1.00 per page but none may be received.

Library Cards

All residents of Lebanon are eligible for free library cards. Please bring personal identification and proof of address to register for a library card. A parent/legal guardian must be present when children are registered. Children under 8 years must be accompanied by an adult while in the library. Your library card is accepted at all public libraries in Connecticut. Please report name/address changes and lost or stolen cards immediately. Replacement fee for a lost card is \$2.00. Library cards are required when checking out materials, accessing your library account online, or using the online resources of *researchIT CT*. The library has the right to restrict privileges of anyone who misuses library materials or violates library policies.

Access

The library staff does not restrict access to materials on the basis of the age of the borrower. *Parents and caregivers are responsible for supervision of children in their selection of print and non-print materials.*

Loan Periods

Most materials are loaned for 21 days and may be renewed for an additional 21 days. The newest DVDs are loaned for 7 days and are not renewable. Fiction DVDs are loaned for 7 days. Sets and non-fiction DVDs are loaned for 14 days. DVDs are not renewable. All "new" books are loaned for 21 days and are not renewable. Museum passes are loaned for 3 days. Magazines are loaned for 14 days and are renewable. Teachers and homeschoolers may speak to a librarian regarding extended loan periods.

Overdue Fines

An overdue fine of \$.10 per day per item will be charged, to a maximum of \$3.00. DVDs are subject to a \$.50 per day overdue fine, to a maximum of \$5.00. Museum passes are subject to a \$5.00 per day overdue fee.

Returning Materials

Materials are returned to the circulation desks during library hours or in the drop box located outside the main entrance. *(Please note: All puppets must be returned when the library is open and must not be put in the book drop. Also, no donations should be put in the book drop or left outside the library.)* Materials must be returned before the library closes on the date they are due in order to avoid a late fee. Materials borrowed from Jonathan Trumbull Library may be returned to any other public library in Connecticut, *with the exception of puppets, which should be returned directly to JTL*. Items from other town libraries can be returned to the Jonathan Trumbull Library and will be forwarded to the appropriate library via the *deliverIT CT* system. Please note that each patron is responsible for all materials until such time as they are received by the lending library.
